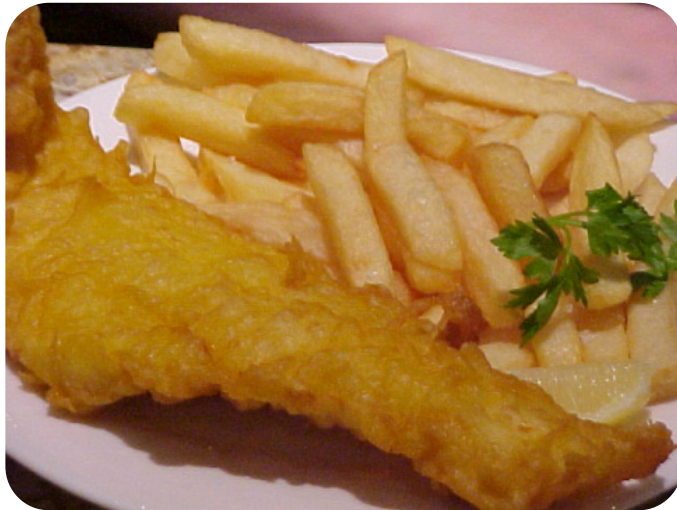

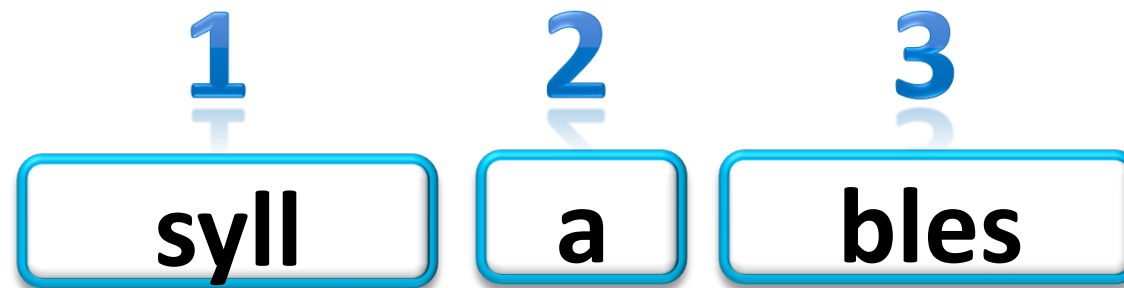

We use *comparative + than* when we want to compare one thing with another

- Sushi is more expensive than salad (*expensive*).
- Tom yam is more delicious than salad (*delicious*).
- Salad is healthier than fish and chips (*healthy*).
- Fish and chips are more unhealthy than sushi (*unhealthy*).
- Tom yam is spicier than sushi with wasabi (*spicy*).
- Fish and chips are oilier than tom yam (*oily*).
- Sushi is saltier than salad (*salty*).

- Salad is not as oily as tom yam (*oily*).
- Sushi is not as salty as fish and chips (*salty*).

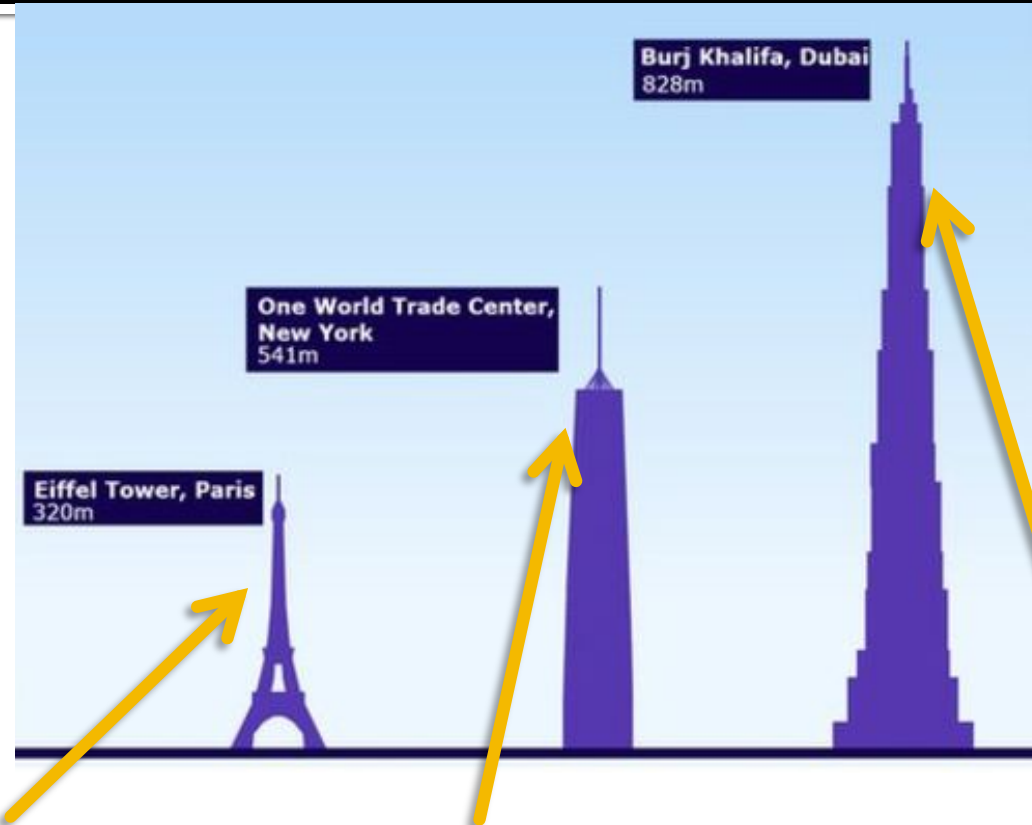

- Salad / unhealthy / fish and chips Salad is **not as unhealthy as** fish and chips.
- Tom yam / spicy / salad Tom yam is **spicier than** salad.
- Sushi / oily / tom yam Sushi is **not as oily as** tom yam.
