Making guesses

MUST

- 90% certain: We use 'must' when something is highly probable.
 - The owner of the bag **must** be a man.
 - You've worked hard all day. You must be tired.
 - She must be happy.



Making guesses

- MAY/COULD/MIGHT
 - 50% certain: We use 'may,' 'could,' or 'might' when something is possible.
 - This person may/could/might like to watch movies.
 - Someone is calling. It may/could/might be my sister.
 - He might be nervous.



Review

MUST

- 90% certain: We use 'must' when something is highly probable.
 - The owner of the bag must be a man.
- MAY/COULD/MIGHT
 - 50% certain: We use 'may,' 'could,' or 'might' when something is possible.
