Making guesses

- MUST
 - 90% certain: We use ‘must’ when something is highly probable.
 - The owner of the bag **must** be a man.
 - You’ve worked hard all day. You **must** be tired.
 - She **must** be happy.



Making guesses

- MAY/COULD/MIGHT
 - 50% certain: We use ‘may,’ ‘could,’ or ‘might’ when something is possible.
 - This person **may/could/might** like to watch movies.
 - Someone is calling. It **may/could/might** be my sister.
 - He **might** be nervous.



Review

- MUST
 - 90% certain: We use ‘must’ when something is highly probable.
 - The owner of the bag **must** be a man.
- MAY/COULD/MIGHT
 - 50% certain: We use ‘may,’ ‘could,’ or ‘might’ when something is possible.
